
PUBLIC NOTICE

 - That the Parish Council write to all allotment holders informing them that any vehicles brought to the allotment gardens through Acorn Croft must be parked on the allotment car park and no vehicles are to be parked on Acorn Croft.
 - That the Parish Council to assist the clearance of rubbish accumulated on some allotment plots which may have been inherited from previous tenants make a skip available on a published day to enable removal in a supervised manner.
